Prior to registration, please use this guide to select the courses you would like to take. You should make two lists.

- 1. List of courses that would give you a schedule of at least 15 hours (usually 5 courses)
- 2. List of alternate courses in case any of the courses on your first list are unavailable.

Please check your ECU email account for information regarding academic advisor assignment. Advisor assignment happens after you pay your enrollment deposit. If you have not been contacted by an advisor a week after registering, email ppac@ecu.edu.

CHOOSE YOUR FALL COURSES: To graduate in four years, plan to register for a 15-16 semester hour schedule every fall and spring semester. To be full-time for tuition purposes register for at least 12 semester hours.

Note: Admission to law school does not require a specific undergraduate major. Law schools are looking for students with strong oral and written communication, analytical thinking skills, and leadership skills. As an undecided pre-law student there are no specific courses required in your first semester. Your goal should be to take a variety of general education courses and electives to begin exploring major options.

Step 2: Register for 12-18 credit hours (15-16 is recommended). Some suggested options are listed below, but you are not limited to these. If courses are full continue to check for open seats through the first week of classes.
